PROGRAM OVERVIEW

The future of business is equitable and to successfully innovate and maintain a competitive advantage, organizations must embrace inclusion wholeheartedly. The Equity Fluent Leadership (EFL) Academy is an equity and inclusion training designed for business leaders who aspire to further equity and inclusion in their organizations and drive impactful change. Participants will learn what it means to be an Equity Fluent Leader, why it matters, and key EFL strategies and tools to ignite and accelerate change within their organizations.

PROGRAM STRUCTURE

Led by the Center for Equity, Gender & Leadership (EGAL) at UC Berkeley's Haas School of Business, the three-day EFL Academy employs a research-driven curriculum, active classroom discussions, and participant self-reflection to empower participants to hone their own equitable leadership.

Distinguished Teaching Fellow, <u>Kellie McElhaney</u>, <u>PhD</u>, guides leaders through the process of learning and applying strategies to advance belonging and psychological safety in their organization and teams, how to communicate and use language that advances inclusion, and how to have courageous conversations related to diversity, equity, and inclusion. Ultimately, participants will walk away with knowledge, strategies, and tools that equip them to drive change for positive impact within their organizations and in the broader community.
