To be a high-potential, emerging leader it is imperative to have the skillsets and knowledge to gain influence and increase impact across an organization. This virtual program explains how to put theory into action, work to improve colleagues' perceptions and bond the differences to collaborate more effectively. As a participant, you will learn to:

- Apply the PACE (Pick, Apprise, Collect, Elicit) leadership self-development model to increase professional influence and impact
- Design a development path that builds relevant skill sets and channels your passions
- Explore transitions, including moving up and laterally in an organization
- Enlist colleagues' help in achieving leadership goals and milestones

WHAT YOU WILL LEARN

The rigorous 12-week curriculum is structured around 12 live online sessions paralleled with the self-development PACE exercises and personal development mentor sessions. Each week, you will experience the power of the HBS Live Online Classroom—discussing, debating, and engaging live with faculty and peers. The live classroom sessions will take place every Tuesday between January 19 and April 6 from 2:00 PM to 4:00 PM ET. Participants will need to log into the Live Online Classroom 30 minutes before the start of each session to conduct a technical check. Key topics will include:

- Understand your leadership profile
- Select goals to increase your professional influence and impact
- Prepare to take advantage of leapfrog opportunities in your career
- Design a leadership development path that builds relevant skillsets and channels your passions
- Explore leadership development transitions including moving up and laterally
- Enlist colleagues' help in achieving leadership goals and milestones
- Communicate for influence across the organization
- Bridge differences and collaborate more effectively
- Learn how to develop your leadership skills throughout your career

WHO SHOULD ATTEND

This program is appropriate for emerging leaders that want to develop the tools and techniques to manage their leadership trajectory and influence across their organization, including top performing individuals with 5-15 years of experience in roles of increasing responsibilities. The program also benefits early and mid-career professionals that want to assess where they are in their professional development and map out a plan to take their role and responsibilities to the next level.
